Summary of 2022

Homeless families are being sheltered

The 38 families who were once homeless, found emergency shelter that allowed their family composition to stay together as they rebuild.

Grants and donations continue to grow

A total of 81 children were able to stay in residence with their own families, access academic support, and maintain social connections while in shelter.

Keeping families together

New Futures increased resources for support of our mission and continued to maintain relationships with those who have long been contributors.

Children stay with their own families

New Futures remained committed to prioritizing the goal of keeping families together who could not find shelter at other facilities and stay together.

Adults are able to move from crisis to stability

The 51 adults who came to New Futures in 2022 were able to find employment, education, and other resources needed to become more self-sufficient and capable of returning to independent housing.

2022 offered continued progress for the organization and families that we serve through the use of the Pathway to Sustainability Model and Assessment. New Futures' use of the Charity Tracker tool increased case management capacity and accountability.
