"EARN IT" CHOICES

During their time in the shelter, our families always have the choice of how to handle their affairs. While some may choose to contribute to their cost share with payments to secure more time with family, all have the opportunity to sign up and complete "Earn It" Chores. By participating in this program, all their financial resources can go toward moving forward into permanent housing.

"EARN IT" PAYMENTS

Residents sign up to participate in "Earn It" Chores provided each week, and at the end of that time all those who completed tasks, will receive an "Earn It" Check. They can use these "Earn It" funds toward cost share, rather than needing to contribute any money. New Futures provided \$18,935 in "Earn It" Payments to residents in 2023.

WHEN HELPING HURTS...

New Futures has led community book discussions on the principles behind "good" charity. Using the curriculum from "When Helping Hurts", we hope to encourage those in the community to be good stewards of their resources and minimize dependency while maximizing relationships. While so many in our community aspire to do good, we must first ensure that we are not doing harm to those we encounter.

Referral options for housing

New Futures is actively seeking opportunities to partner with existing spaces or build new places that would increase affordable housing options for the community. We see success occurring when families are supported by case management and provided opportunities to change.



Financially stable

New Futures has made progress financially by purchasing our shelter, developing a savings plan for operating costs, and being fiscally responsible with our resources. We model the behaviors and goals we hope to foster in our families.

Additionally, New Futures became accredited by the Better Business Bureau (BBB), as a symbol of our commitment to transparency.



Volunteer Experiences

In 2023, New Futures finally experienced volunteer hours greater than our pre-pandemic participation. Hundreds of volunteers came out to provide approximately 2,115 hours of volunteer support. We continue to look for partners in the community who desire to build relationships with our families through their service.

Many families are not in a situation that will allow them to move into traditional housing (due to evictions, credit score, trouble saving for deposits, etc.) We are partnering with landlords who will give our families a chance at transitional housing while they work on these issues. New Futures provides essential case management and guarantees collection of cost share.

Add more transitional housing opportunities for residents and help decrease barriers to housing.

Continue to work towards increasing resources for case mgt & housing navigation opportunities in the community to help meet these needs.



Find more partners to collaborate with in the community to provide better resources for residents.

Through participation in Community Connections, Charity Tracker, ALHelp.org, and other collaborations resources can be found and needs can be met.



Look for opportunities to allow the funding of a multi-purpose room on site.

Ideally, this building would be the size of a half court gym and could be used for group meetings, recreation, etc.



Encourage volunteer or financial support to help increase after school, summer, and school break activities for children.

By offering activities to children (STEM, dance, art, recreation, etc.) they become more comfortable and well adjusted.
