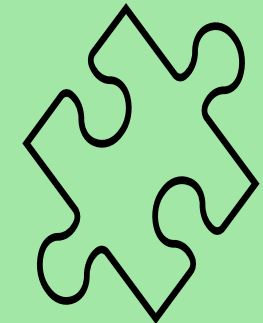

Housing Opportunities

New Futures continues to look for partners in the community to allow second chance housing for those we serve. We have continued to find new resources in the community for our families.

Financial Transparency

New Futures successfully completed the first full financial audit in its history in 2024. The completion of this will allow new opportunities for securing grants and the recruitment of partners.

Volunteer Experiences

In 2024, New Futures recorded 1,698 hours of volunteer support, spanning more than 700 individual volunteers. We continue to see new volunteers and increased partnerships from within the community.

Through partnership with Neighborhood Concepts, HOME-ARP grant funding was secured that will allow for the construction of a 42-unit apartment complex on Venona Ave., directly across from current shelter to serve in assisting homeless in need of transitional services.

Transitional Housing

New Futures has always had healthy numbers for those who would move into housing from shelter. In 2024, there was an increase of 40%, in families successfully completing New Futures. The availability of increased housing opportunities for our residents is one of the major factors in this.

Successful Completions

A FEW GOALS FOR 2025...



Continue to add transitional housing opportunities to decrease barriers for housing.

Initiate transitional housing application wait list, to better track families in need of housing options, and encourage landlords to support program.



Begin construction on apartment complex, known as New Stone Commons, to help with transitional housing for homeless.

Through partnership with Neighborhood Concepts, Inc. these units will be built and serve those ready to transition from homelessness.



Look for opportunities to allow the funding of a multi-purpose room on site.

While we improved outdoor spaces, a building for use when it is cold or raining is still greatly needed. Ideally, this building would be at least the size of a half court gym and could be used for group meetings, recreation, etc.



Capital Campaign to help pay down mortgage on shelter before required refinancing occurs in Oct. 2025

The goal is to raise approximately \$265,000. The release of this payment would allow for additional funding to support transitional housing.
